BSEP Summer Workshop Descriptions

Behavioral Health

Through interdisciplinary presentations students will learn about behavioral healthcare and careers in the field. Mental health and physical health are intricately linked, and the current impact of mental health on the care of patients is becoming critical. Students will hear from doctors, nurses, counselors, and other essential providers working to support patients struggling with mental health and behavioral health.

Available to all high school grades

Chronic Illnesses - Healthcare

Identifying and managing chronic illness is a critical part health care and involves teams for multiple professions and specialties. In this course students will be introduced to three common chronic illnesses and talk about diagnosis, treatment and prevention. Over the course of three days, the student will learn about asthma, diabetes & heart disease. Students will gain knowledge and skills on these illnesses present, how they are managed, and the impacts the diseases have on the patients who have them.

Available to all high school grades

Health Care Pathways – Local Programs

During this workshop we'll visit local colleges and universities where students will be able to tour and participate in activities related to healthcare career training programs. Presenters will also discuss a general overview of the healthcare programs offered at each school. The colleges and universities may include Westfield State University, Holyoke Community College (HCC), Springfield Technical Community College (STCC) and UMASS.

Available to rising 1tth and 12th graders

Surgical Services

This course will be an introduction to surgical services and how the operating rooms at the hospital function. Participants will be exposed to a variety of careers and pathways in and around the operating room. They will also learn about different cases, specialties and practices as it relates to types of surgery conducted at Baystate Medical Center. The group will visit an operating room used for education.
