# BSEP Course Descriptions

## Fall 2024

### **Career Exploration Courses (Level 1)**

Career exploration (CE) courses are offered to allow students the opportunity to explore the diverse range of careers available within the health and biomedical sciences. CE courses provide students with knowledge of a wide variety of health related fields by creating career connections with health care professionals. Enrollment in a CE course is **required** for all first time BSEP students. At the end of the course, students will participate in a culminating experience building presentation skills and sharing their envisioned future within health care.

#### ***Career Exploration: Nursing***

BSEP Nursing offers students the chance to explore a nursing career. Practicing nurses from varying nursing disciplines will talk to BSEP students about their nursing education, career choice and the day-to-day responsibilities in the field. Students will also learn typical skills required of a nurse and explore the educational pathway to a nursing degree

**All high school grades**

#### ***Career Exploration: Allied Health***

In this course, students will have the chance to learn about typical activities in various allied health professions and help them identify potential careers that match their interests, strengths, and goals. Representatives from a range of in-demand professions will offer firsthand information on career choices and educational requirements for pursuing those careers. Students can explore such areas as respiratory therapy, mental health counselor, lab technician, and imaging technician (these careers have not been confirmed and the actual professions may be different than the ones listed).

#### ***Teen Mini-Medical School (TMMS)***

TMMS offers students direct interaction with physicians through the presentation of medical specialties. Students will participate in case discussions, simulation activities and tour the hospital as it relates to various medical careers as allowed (some restrictions apply). The course gives experience of the medical processes of care as well as important insights into the career path of physicians.

# Fall 2024

## Career Development Courses (Level 2)

After taking at least **two** Career Exploration courses, BSEP students are encouraged to enroll in one of the courses below. These courses provide students with an opportunity to understand college and career planning and gain experience observing a specific career pathway.

### ***Patient Care Skills***

Patient care skills go beyond the technical skills required to treat a patient. In this course, students will advance their understanding of the role of the health care professional through the exploration of case studies and an introduction to more advanced patient care skills as it relates to bedside manner. Students will get the chance to use these skills by participating in the Baystate simulation lab.

**Grades 11 -12 only**

**Prerequisite: Nursing I or TMMS**

### ***Job Mentoring: Medicine, Nursing, and Allied Health***

Job mentoring is an observation experience course where students learn about a job by walking through two hours of a workday as a "shadow" to a practicing health care professional. The student will complete seven observations. The job mentoring experience is a temporary, unpaid exposure to the hospital environment in an occupational area of interest to the student. Students observe firsthand the work environment, employability and occupational skills in practice, the value of professional training and potential career options. Job shadowing is designed to increase career awareness, help model student behavior through examples and reinforce the link between classroom learning and work requirements.

**Prerequisite: Two Exploration Courses**
