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# BSEP Session Descriptions

## Summer 2017

### **Themed 3-Day Workshops**

Themed workshops are offered by BSEP to give students the opportunity to explore the issues surrounding specified health issues and the varied careers associated with them. Students will present and discuss key questions and issues regarding the designated theme. Taking one themed workshop prepares students for continuing participation in the BSEP program in the fall of 2017.

#### ***Crime Scene Investigation Workshop***

In this workshop, students will investigate the science behind blood typing, fingerprinting, facial recognition, and other biometrics. While a hospital does not solve crimes, it does need to understand why people have become ill or died, or why a medical mistake may have occurred. During the course of three days, the group will explore these different types of investigations.

***For students in high school in Fall of 2017***

#### ***Opioid Crisis – Impact on Health Care, the Community and You***

In this workshop, students will be taught the risks, benefits, and effects of opioid pain medications. Students will learn the pathophysiology of overdosing... and the reality of what happens from the moment EMT's are called to the scene, to the life-saving measures that are employed in the Emergency Department to care related, to admission and discharge from the hospital. Participants will learn ways to advocate for appropriate and safe pain management, gain a preventative outlook on prescription use/misuse, and mentor peers and future patients.

***For students in high school in Fall of 2017***

#### ***Public Health and Prevention Workshop***

In this workshop, students will explore public health and prevention in an effort to understand the transitions underway in health care practices and economics. Participants will understand the causes and structures of health care problems and disparities and understand many efforts underway to address them. Learn about the future of community health work and holistic efforts to improve health outcomes and reduce health care costs.

***For students in high school in Fall of 2016***

#### ***Cardio-Vascular / CPR Workshop***

In this workshop, students will investigate issues of health related to the heart and the circulatory system. Participants will review the cardio vascular system and learn about its impacts on a number of health concerns. If available, the group will work through simulated care scenarios to the heart. The last day (August 4<sup>th</sup>) is scheduled for CPR training which will provide the students with a CPR card from HeartSaver *Note that the last day is Friday and there is no Thursday class.*
